

DISCIPLINE AND CODE OF CONDUCT

GENERAL RULES

- 1. The students have to attend lectures, tutorial, practical's as per the time-table.
- The absence for a long time without necessary permission may result in the short fail in attendance and the consequents loss of the terms.

GYMKHANA RULES:
